- 3 Attend Local, Regional and National Events** While the Frozen Fins have monthly get togethers, as a member you can also attend any event held by other clubs, including the New England Parrot Head Convention and Meeting of the Minds in Key West. Both are multi-day events attended by Parrot Heads from across the country that raise money and feature live music. This past March 2nd thru 4th, the New England Convention was held in Manchester, NH and it raised over \$26,000 for NH area charities. Vermont is scheduled to host the Convention in 2015.
